Preservation of Physical Evidence

What is the physical evidence found at the fire scene and how can the fire department preserve the evidence that is required to prove the cause of the fire? Evidence must be recognized early on, and proper care must be utilized to preserve critical evidence in all types of fire. Basic overhaul of a fire scene can be critical in maintaining a fire scene.

Basic Interviewing

What simple questions need to be asked immediately after a fire has been brought under control to ensure that the most accurate information is obtained, and to insure notification of the proper agencies.

Documentation of the Fire Scene

The proper procedure to document the event from the initial call until the point you leave the scene. An easy method to memorialize the scene and to assist in future actions. Report writing, depositions, and a possible trial.
