The applicant must apply on firearson.com and provide documentation of meeting minimum requirements including experience, training, and education. Upon approval they must successfully pass a comprehensive practicum examination.

Prerequisites

REQUIREMENTS/EXPERIENCE:

- A minimum of 18 months of general experience in a fire investigation related industry.
- A minimum of 12 items of forensic evidence collected. The applicant is responsible for submitting general supporting documents that include the location of the examination, the date of the examination, and the particular type(s) of evidence collected.
- Minimum of 29 hours of tested training.

- Documenting the Event (4 hours)
- Ethics and the Fire Investigator (3 hours)
- The Scientific Method for Fire and Explosion Investigation (3 hours)

- NFPA 1033 and Your Career (2 hours)

COMPREHENSIVE PRACTICAL EXAMINATION:

- Applicants must pass all critical elements and achieve a minimum score of 70% on each of the 10 components of the practical testing to be deemed to have successfully challenged the exam. Examination Period: Four Hours

The training subjects provided meet their respective requirements of NFPA 1033, 2022 edition. This conference is providing 24 hours of tested training. Testing will be completed on CFITrainer.net, using a PIN number that will be provided at the end of the conference.

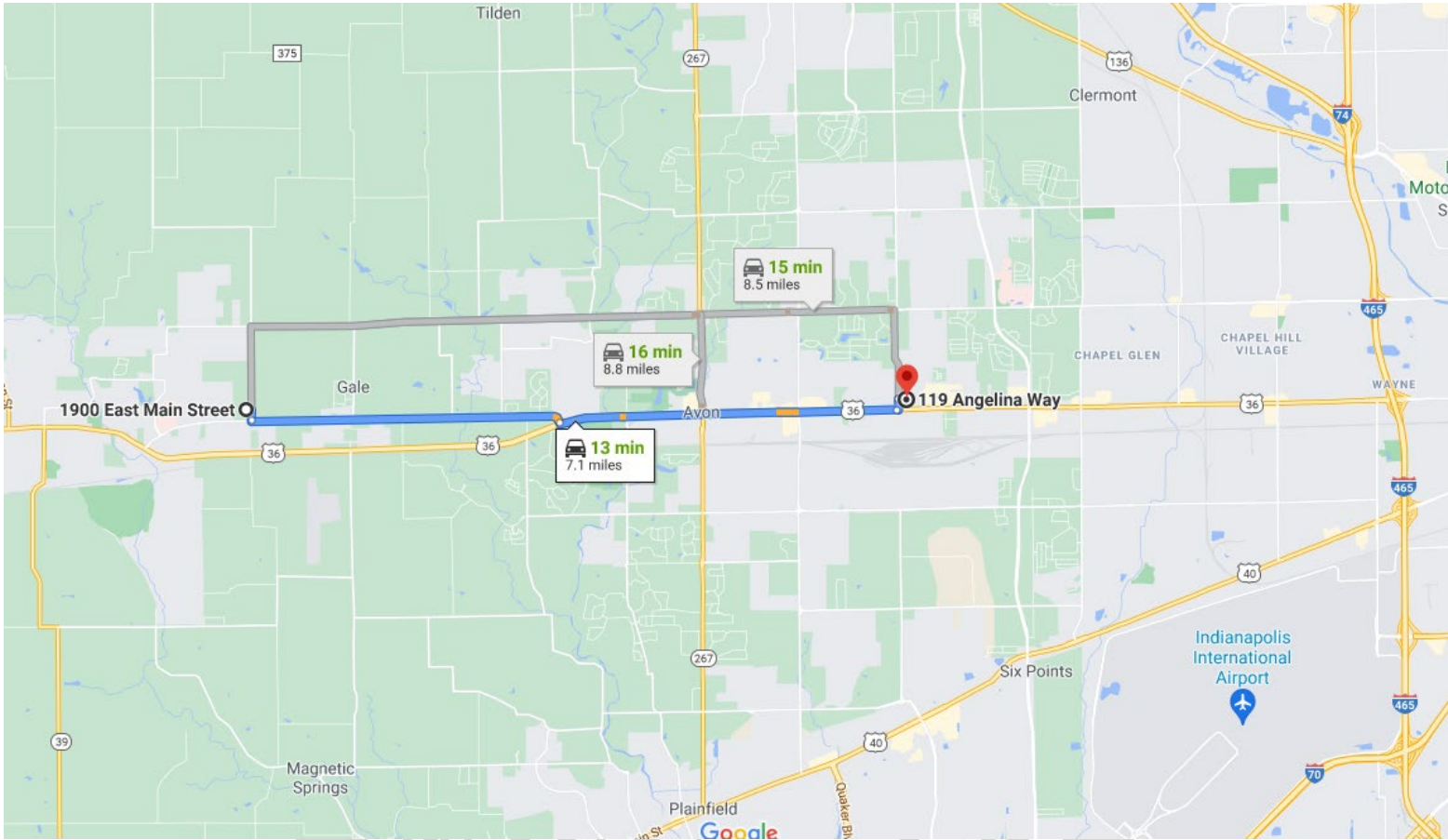
